The Twerdun Scholarship will be available for all participants 12 – 18 years of age that are competing in the following classes:

- **Equitation A, B (4 classes) 171, 172, 173, 174**
- **Jump Canada Hunter Medal (1 class) 183**
- **CET Mini Medal (1 class) 184**
- **CET Medal (1 class) 185**

The competitor with the most accrued points will be presented with the Scholarship. Points will be awarded as listed below, and multiplied by the number of entries competing in the class, as determined by the count on the judges card or, if this is not available then by the secretary's count.

1st place – 8 points

2nd place – 6 points

3rd place – 5 points

4th place – 4 points

5th place – 3 points

6th place – 2 points

7th place – 1 point.

In the case of a tie, the competitor with the most points over fences will be awarded the winner.

Terms & Conditions:

- You **MUST** be attending school to acquire the money. The money will only be distributed once school registration has been confirmed. The money will be allocated to the school tuition and distributed to the University or College of choice.
- The type of post-secondary school enrollment, i.e. what course you decide to take does not affect the scholarship.
- If you choose not to attend a post-secondary school, the money will be forfeited.
- If the applicant is not of age to attend post-secondary school, the Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba will hold the funds for up to 2 years from your High School Graduation date. If the money is not acquired from 2 years of High School graduation, the money will be forfeited.
- There will be no interest accrued while the funds are in hold.

This Scholarship will be awarded Saturday evening immediately following the Grand Prix ribbon presentation and the KT McPherson award presentation. The winner must be present in the Arena to receive the scholarship from the Sponsor.
